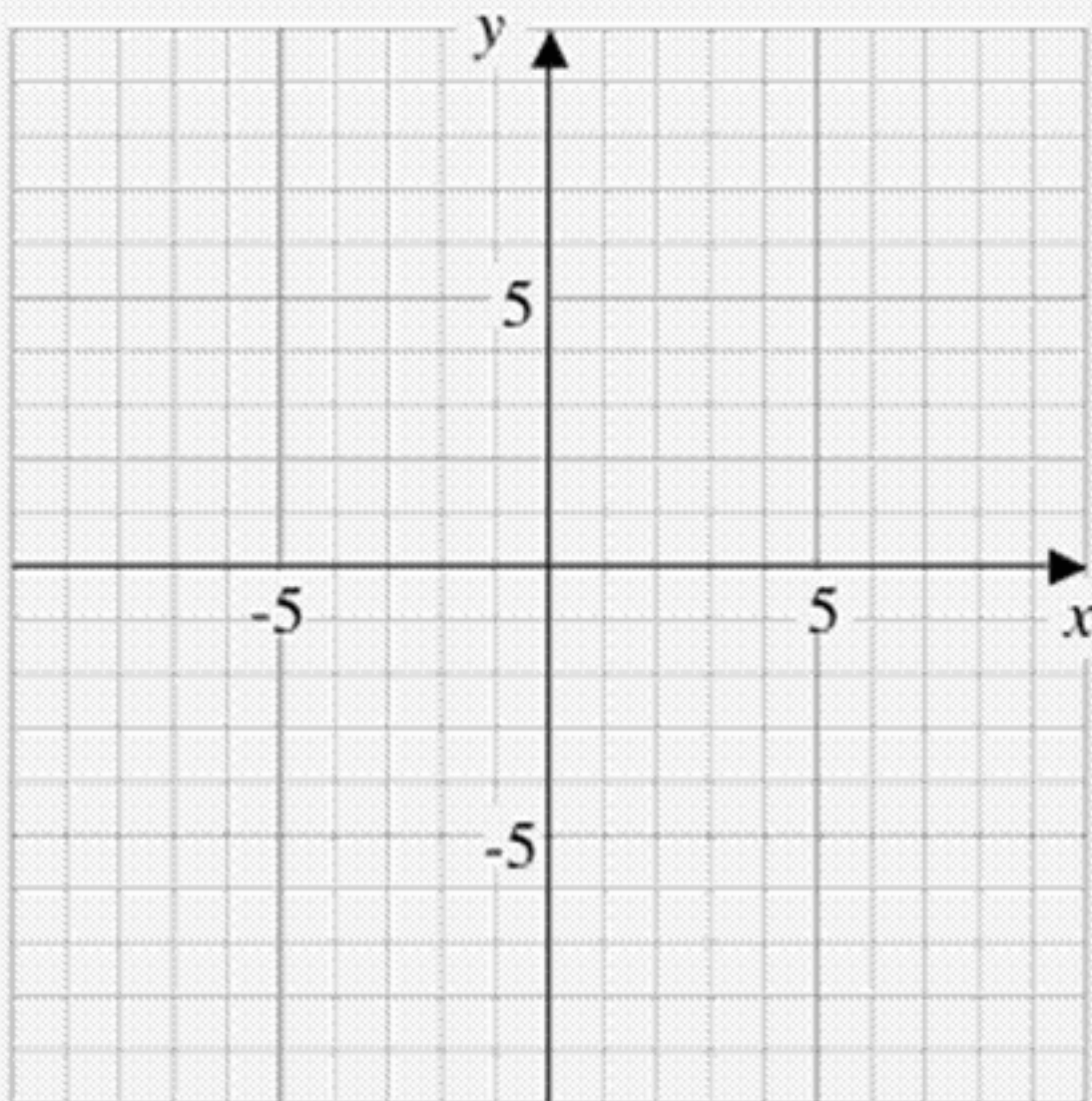
Rules in Math:

When graphing a point, the first number or coordinate (x) in the ordered pair (x,y) tells you how many spaces to go left or right. The second number (y) tells you how many spaces to go up or down. Start at 0.
